- Provides organizational security best practices for validating, prioritizing, and delivering valid security processes and methodology through the development of ITIL based Security Standard Operating Procedures, Tactics, Techniques and Procedures, Enterprise Security Plans.
- Ensures security DoD business best practices are implemented and are compliant with DoD and Army regulations and policies
- Works independently as the security manager. Works with all Senior technical staff and assigned security teams members to ensure security business best practices are implemented into day-to-day USARCC-C internal and external support. Sets security related priorities and organizes security work to meet Army and USARCC-C customer deadlines
- Follows Army USARCC-C security business and organizational processes, polices, and instructions
- Personnel Security - Will have overall responsibility for verification of personnel's security clearances, performing security in and out-processing activities, create, issue proper identification badges, maintain area physical security via customer door access system and issuance of classified security tokens and smart cards to USARCC-C employee's and other Army NETCOM stakeholders.
- Network Security - Will have overall responsibility for Information Assurance vulnerability management processes and implementations that included performing monthly network scans, coordinating scan results, documenting and recording scans and actions taken IAW USARCC-C SOPs and TTPs. Will be responsible for maintaining IAVM notifications and compliance and develop and prepare IAVA impact statement and reports. Will be responsible for ensuring USARCC-C team members comply with security and IAVA deadlines as set forth by the Army and DoD. Will be responsible for scans for unauthorized software, perform antivirus audits and ensures virus definitions are up-to-date.
- System and Network Connection Security– Will have overall responsibility for ensure system and USARCC-C managed network accreditations are documented and maintained.

- Physical Security.
